Biographical Sketch:

Dorothy Adeline Benson (nee McLean) was born in Kamloops, B.C. on April 16, 1897, the daughter of Alexander McLean and Margaret (Cesaire) McLean. She married Herman O. Benson on September 12, 1914, with whom she had two daughters (Beryl Spiers and Dorothy McEwan) and one son (Stanley). Dorothy Adeline Benson died in Kamloops, B.C. on January 7, 1977 at age 80.

Herman O. Benson was born on March 16, 1892 in Oklahoma. He was married to Dorothy Adeline McLean on September 12, 1914, with whom he had two daughters (Beryl Spiers and Dorothy McEwan) and one son (Stanley). Herman O. Benson died on January 12, 1964 in Colville, Washington.

Scope and Content:

Fonds consists predominantly of funerary records and ephemera related to Dorothy Adeline Benson and Herman O. Benson, as well as their marriage certificate. Also included in the fonds are a baptismal certificate for Dorothy Adeline McLean, a funeral record for Beulah Ellen White, and photographs of the Benson family.

Custodial History:

Records from accession 1981.003 were donated to the Kamloops Museum and Archives on January 12, 1981 by Dorothy McEwan, the daughter of Herman O. and Dorothy Adeline Benson. Photographs from this accession were initially removed and placed in the Photograph Collection by former KMA staff. Records were brought back together during reprocessing in 2020. In the file with the photographs from accession 1981.003 were two duplicate negatives of a photograph, which was assumed to be related to the Benson Family. Negatives were summarily accessioned in 2020 during reprocessing as accession 2020.004.

Notes:

Arrangement: Order that fonds arrived in was maintained by the archivist.
