Biographical Sketch:

Francis Bernard Connors was born on September 17, 1887 in Chatham, Nova Scotia. On January 13, 1915 Connors enlisted in the Canadian Expeditionary Forces at the Red Deer recruiting office, and he became part of the Canadian Overseas Railway Construction Corps (C.O.R.C.C.) due to his training as a civil engineer. Connors survived the war, and went on to marry and have at least one son (Donald F. Connors). After the war it seems that Connors gained employment with first the Calgary and Southwestern Railway Co. and then the Canadian Pacific Railway Company.

Scope and Content:

Fonds consists of three publications by the Canadian Pacific Railway Company and the Calgary and Southwestern Railway Co. dealing with the construction of spiral curves and general railway operations.

Custodial History:

Accession 1995.037 was donated to the Kamloops Museum and Archives on November 29, 1995 by Donald F. Connors, the son of Francis Bernard Connors.
