Biographical Sketch:

Patience Kent Cross (nee Wynn) was born on February 12, 1937 in Edmonton, Alberta, the daughter of Wilfrid Wynn and Mary Senetchka. On July 14, 1956 she married Donald Cross in Edmonton, with whom she had a son (David John) and a daughter (Susan Dawn). The family moved to Penticton, B.C. soon after their marriage, and would later settle in Kamloops in 1964. After raising her children, Cross enrolled in the Nursing Program at Kamloops' Cariboo College in 1975 and would graduate with her nursing diploma in July 1977. During this period Cross and her husband would separate. After graduation, Cross worked at the Royal Inland Hospital and at the Burris Clinic, before settling into a permanent position at Ponderosa Lodge as a Night Nurse. Patience Kent Cross died on January 30, 2000 in Kamloops, B.C. at the age of 64.

Scope and Content:

Fonds consists of records relating to Patience Cross' attendance at Cariboo College's Nursing School during the later 1970s.

Custodial History:

Accession 2000.052 was donated to the Kamloops Museum and Archives on July 27, 2000 by Susan Cross, the daughter of Patience Cross.
