Biographical Sketch:

Jann Louise Macinnis Bailey was born on March 12, 1952 in Hamilton, Ontario, the daughter of John William Bailey and Dr. Edna Mae MacInnis. During her youth she lived in Ancaster and Dundas and attended Sarah Lawrence University, before moving to Toronto to attend the Ontario College of Art and Design. Graduating with honours in 1976, Bailey then went on to manage the Art Gallery of Hamilton and to teach at Fleming College (1984-1987), where she would later become the Head of Arts Administration and Art Conservation. In 1987 Bailey moved to Kamloops, B.C. after accepting a position as the Executive Director of the Kamloops Art Gallery. She would remain in this capacity for the following 28 years, and was instrumental in the gallery's move to a new purpose-built civic facility at 465 Victoria Street in 1998. Over her career Bailey received numerous awards and honours for her contributions to the art world and community, including the Governor General's Canada 125 Award (1992), Y's Woman of Distinction Award (1995), Queen's Silver Jubilee Medal (2003), and an Honorary Doctorate of Arts and Letters from Thompson Rivers University (2008). Bailey was married to Alan Stephenson. Jann Louise Macinnis Bailey died on October 9, 2015 in Kamloops, B.C. of leukemia.

Scope and Content:

Fonds consists of records from the estate of Jann L.M. Bailey. Records include magazines and clippings which mention Bailey, records related to her Celebration of Life, photographs, a share certificate, land purchase records, records related to her Honorary Doctorate of Letters and Arts degree (2008), artwork by Bailey, Bailey's copy of a Kamloops history book, and various awards, certificates, and diplomas.
