Administrative History:

The Kamloops Civilian Auxiliary was established in 1943 to aid servicemen during World War 2. It worked most closely with the Royal Canadian Navy HMCS Kamloops and Royal Canadian Air Force 419 Battalion "Moose Squadron."

Scope and Content:

Fonds consists of minutes, reports, and correspondence of the Kamloops Civilian Auxiliary from 1943-1946.

Custodial History:

Records were donated to the Kamloops Museum and Archives at an unknown date by Mrs. F.J. Fulton, the secretary of the organization. Fonds was originally comprised of only materials from accession 0.2870. Material from accession 0.3132 was originally placed on the Soldier's Comfort Club fonds, and was added to this fonds during reprocessing in 2017. Accession 0.2888 was originally placed in the Vertical Files collection, and was accrued to this fonds during reprocessing in 2019.
