Administrative History:

The Kamloops Community Volunteer Services Society, operating as Volunteer Kamloops, is an organization which provides connections between organizations in Kamloops and volunteers. The society was established in 1985, with a mandate to support and strengthen volunteerism in Kamloops and the area through promotion, recruitment, education, orientation, and referral services. The society hosts an annual event in April for National Volunteer Week, and actively participates in community initiatives towards volunteerism. Currently, the society's three main programs are the FOCUS program, which provides connections between organizations and mental health consumers; the Link program, a referral program connecting volunteers with organizations; and the Snow Angels Program, which provides snow removal for seniors and those with mobility limitations.

Scope and Content:

Fonds consists of records relating to the travelling exhibition by Volunteer Canada hosted at the Kamloops Museum and Archives in 2000 entitled "Volunteering Through Time," in which the Kamloops Community Volunteer Services Society was involved. Records include photographs, promotional materials, and correspondence.

Custodial History:

Accession 2001.004 was donated to the Kamloops Museum and Archives on January 30, 2001 by Judy Nielsen, the former Executive Director, on behalf of the Kamloops Community Volunteer Services Society.
