Dates of Creation: 1912-1958 (predominantly 1957-1958)

Physical Description: 11.5 cm of textual records and 2 maps

Administrative History:

The **Kamloops and District Centennial (1958) Committee** sponsored and organized events in the Kamloops area to commemorate the 1958 centennial of British Columbia.

Scope and Content:

Fonds consists of minutes, correspondence, reports, and bylaws of the Kamloops and District Centennial (1958) Committee and various promotional ephemera related to the centennial celebration.

Custodial History:

Fonds was originally comprised of accessions 1968.022 (Committee records) and 1978.045.014 (banner for the Yellowhead Highway). Additional material was accrued to this collection during reprocessing in 2018 (accessions 2018.001, 2018.002, 0.2542, and 0.2547) and 2019 (accessions 0.2786, 1978.080, and 1983.010).

Accessions 0.2547 and 0.2786 have no donor information. Accession 1968.022 was donated to the Kamloops Museum and Archives on February 26, 1968 by Mrs. Freeman Snider (per Mayor Peter Wing). Accession 1978.080 was donated on December 27, 1978 by Jim Ferrier. Accession 1983.010 was donated in March 1983 by Lawrence Maki. Accession 1984.031 was transferred on April 16,

1984 from the Armstrong Historical Society. Accession 2018.001 was donated in June 1959 by the City of Kamloops. Accession 2018.002 was donated in December 1959 by Dave Arnott.

Materials from accessions 0.2542 and 1978.045 were removed from the fonds and returned to the Artifact Collection during reprocessing in 2019.

Notes:

Source of supplied title: Title based on contents of fonds.

Arrangement: Order of fonds was imposed by the archivist during processing, as no previous arrangement or order had been noted for materials. All material was grouped together approximately chronologically during processing in 2018. During reprocessing in 2019, material was re-arranged into two series to emphasize records originating with the Committee (Series 1: Committee Records) and records collected by participants in centennial events (Series 2: Ephemera). Within each series, records are arranged chronologically by donation.

Access restrictions: No restrictions on access. The archivist reserves the right to restrict access to any fragile material for preservation purposes.

Terms governing use and reproduction: No reproduction permitted without consent of copyright holder. It is the researcher's responsibility to obtain permission for the reproduction of materials for publication or dissemination.
