Administrative History:

The Ladies Auxiliary to the Brotherhood of Railroad Trainmen was formed in the early 1900s as a partner organization to the Brotherhood of Railroad Trainmen, a union for railroad employees. The organization was largely comprised of the wives of union members, and the group acted to organize social events such as dances and masquerades. In January 1970 the group changed its name to the Ladies Auxiliary to the United Transportation Union, Lodge No. 596 to reflect the new name of the trade union. The group was also referred to as the Sisters of A.E. Elliott, Lodge No. 596. In 1992 the organization surrendered their charter and most members transferred to the Penticton Lodge, No. 831.

Scope and Content:

Fonds consists of a Roll Call of Officers booklet, a notebook of receipts and disbursements, a meeting minutes ledger, and a small amount of loose papers including financial documents and correspondence.

Custodial History:

Accession 1998.008 was donated to the Kamloops Museum and Archives on February 24, 1998 by Judy Hay for Nellie Hay. Nellie Hay was the last Secretary Treasurer for the organization.
