Biographical Sketch:

Florence Elizabeth Nelson (nee Knight-Bruce) was born on May 26, 1916 at Kamloops, B.C., the daughter of Sydney Windham Oake Knight-Bruce and Dora Augusta Cannell. Florence married Wilfrid Sextus Nelson on July 14, 1938 at Kamloops, B.C., with whom she had one daughter (Caroll Ann). Florence Elizabeth Nelson died on April 12, 1974 in Kamloops, B.C. at age 57.

Scope and Content:

Fonds consists primarily of records from Nelson's father, Sydney Knight Bruce, and her maternal grandfather, Edmund Cannell. Records include photographs, land records, records related to the Provincial Exhibition and Industrial Exposition, and a book.

Custodial History:

Accession 1974.023 was donated to the Kamloops Museum and Archives between April 13-16, 1974 by the estate of Florence Nelson.
