**Physical Description:** 9 cm of textual records, 7 b&w photographs, 4 maps, and 1 architectural drawing

#### **Biographical Sketch:**

Nelson Andrew Riis was born on January 10, 1942 in High River Alberta. Riis began working at the age of 12 and by the time he was 30 he had worked as a clerk, waiter, fisherman, surveyor, truck driver, timber cruiser, farm labourer, deckhand, and refinery worker. He then decided to enter the teaching profession, gaining a Bachelor of Education at the University of British Columbia and working as an elementary and secondary school teacher throughout the 1960s. Riis went back to the University of British Columbia during the later 1960s to gain a master's degree in geography, and after his graduation in 1970 he became one of the charter members of the Geography Department at Cariboo College in Kamloops, B.C. (now Thompson Rivers University). During his time at Cariboo College Riis would rise to become the chairman of the Social Sciences Department, and became very involved in local politics. Riis won a seat as Alderman in 1973 in Kamloops, where he would serve until 1978. Afterwards he served as a School Trustee (1978-1980) and as a Director for the Thompson Nicola Regional District. In 1980 Riis entered federal politics representing the New Democratic Party, and won the seat for the Kamloops-Shuswap riding. Riis would continue to represent the Kamloops-Shuswap and later Kamloops riding in the House of Commons until his defeat in the 2000 election. During his tenure Riis served as the House Leader (1986-1996) and the Caucus Chair (1996-2000), and was well known during his time as the Critic for Finance. After his retirement from politics Riis continued to live in the Ottawa region, and entered the world of business. From 2000-2010 he worked for Canadian Rockport Homes International, and then went on to start his own business as a long term care planning specialist.

#### Scope and Content:

Fonds consists of Nelson Riis' research materials on the Walhachin area, including maps, water records, maps, and photographs; a booklet on community organizations in Kamloops; and ephemera related to his political career representing the Kamloops-Shuswap (later Kamloops) riding.

### **Custodial History:**

Accession 0.3116 was donated to the Kamloops Museum and Archives ca. 1972 by Nelson Riis. Photographs from this accession were initially integrated into the KMA Photograph Collection, and the remainder of records were filed in the Vertical Files collection. Accession 2018.148 was donated ca. 1981 by Nelson Riis. Records in accession 2020.003 were initially placed in the biographical file about Nelson Riis, but were pulled from the file for permanent preservation by the previous Archivist around 2010 and accessioned in 2020. All three accessions were brought together during reprocessing in 2020.
