Biographical Sketch:

James Todd was born on June 20, 1870 in Barnhartvale, B.C. the son of James and Margaret/Marguerite Todd. In January 1896 he married Margaret (Maggie) Manson, with whom he had two sons (Joseph and James) and three daughters (Margaret Alma, Evelyn/Eveline, and Dorothy/Dolly). Todd took up farming on his father's farm in Barnhartvale, and lived there until he retired to Kamloops in 1940. James Todd died on October 20, 1943 in Kamloops, B.C. at the age of 73.

Scope and Content:

Fonds consists of records related to James Todd, including correspondence, baptismal certificates, financial records, and a registration card for his wife, Margaret.

Custodial History:

Accession 0.3100 has no available donor information. Records were formerly placed in the Vertical Files collection and were brought together as a distinct fonds during processing in 2020.
